## ANZAC services at dawn this year

We have seen a few variations to ANZAC Day commemorations in recent years, driven by the impact of COVID. This year however other factors are coming into play. The Tairua Pauanui **Returned Services Association** committee, faced with a dwindling number of veterans and other logistical obstacles, has decided that both villages will only be holding Dawn Services this year. Neither Pauanui nor Tairua will have the traditional 11am civic services.

Pauanui's Dawn Service will start at 6.30am at the Pauanui Surf Club. Attendees are asked to assemble at 6am. If the weather is inclement the service will be shifted to Pauanui Sports & Recreation

Club. A cooked breakfast will be available at the Pauanui Club from 7.30am for \$15 per plate, being subsidised by the Tairua Pauanui RSA, together with a tot of rum for those needing a warm up!

Tairua's Dawn Service also starts at 6.30am and attendees are asked to assemble at 6am in front of the Commemorative Wall at the Tairua Ex-Servicemen's Cemetery. RSA committee member Warwick Brooks explained this will be an extended Dawn Service with a guest speaker from the NZ Defence Force and school participation. A cooked breakfast for veterans and RSA members will be served following the commemorations at Tairua Rugby & Sports Club.

# 30 Years in the making: Tairua Skatepark is now open

The Tairua Skatepark at Cory Park Domain was officially opened on Monday 15 April, just in time for the school holidays.

The skatepark is a brand new, accessible, family-friendly park that will bring people together and support the development of local talent.

"This project has been decades in the making – and to now see it physically there and open is testament to tenacity of the community who knew this was an important thing for the young people in this ward – not just Tairua, but Pāuanui and Hikuai too," says Mayor Len Salt.

The skatepark was designed alongside its users, with students giving their thoughts on what should be included.

An opening event that took place this week and was a chance thank everyone who has contributed to the project, including the amazing contractors: Acid, Veros, Billy and his landscaping team and Veolia.



Additionally, the Tairua Sport & Recreation Trust – known as the Tairua Skatepark Group – have contributed through their fundraising efforts and ongoing commitment. Also to be thanked were the local Tairua-Pāuanui Community Board who have been a great support throughout the project.

"The build has gone smoothly and we're very proud to open this new community space," Len says. Thanks to everyone who respected the worksite during the build and patiently waited for it to open.
