### Pepe Bridge information session draws good local crowd

The public gathering called by Tairua Residents and Ratepayers Association and hosted by NZ Transport Agency (Waka Kotahi) on Wednesday last week to share information regarding the replacement of Pepe Bridge was well-attended. The session drew concerned, interested and curious locals, giving all attendees the opportunity to be heard.

Prior to the gathering, a relaxed roll-up affair hosted by NZTA staff, rumours had been starting to circulate that the replacement project would entail the removal of the old structure and then the

installation of the new, leaving a long period where the town would be cut in half with no through-access.

Categorically, this will not be the case. The project parameters include maintaining traffic flow throughout. In discussing this matter, it was made clear that there could be times when traffic is stopped to allow for certain installation procedures but it would be temporary and timed to be least inconvenient for road users. Advance warning of such events would be given. Phew!!

The information event

was an opportunity to hear about and make comment on the broad concept plan. Among the images produced for discussion, one showed a two lane bridge with a cycle and pedestrian lane adjoined. The critical issue around the final design and build is the Pepe Road intersection. The diagram showed a pedestrian crossing over the highway to provide a safe and controlled crossing point. Overheard discussion mainly focussed on what a nightmare it could be for vehicles to deal with the pedestrian crossing and the two-way traffic. Staffers had several suggestions on the subject, of which a turn-leftonly scenario made the best sense in my view.

Feedback was solicited

from and provided by those attending on aspects of the bridge replacement and wider roading issues on the Peninsula, although my suggestion that the Kopu-Hikuai Road be returned to 100kph status gained no traction, with the traffic safety statistics identifying this section of SH25 as one of the most dangerous for fatal accidents.

The upshot of the event was that information will be made available as soon as decisions are made regarding each step of the replacement process. 
