TES Daffodil Day success, thanks to all

By all accounts, Daffodil Day 2025 has been very successful in Pauanui and Tairua!

The day before Daffodil Day, a group of volunteers from Pauanui travelled to Cambridge to pick and sort daffodils for the fundraiser. On Daffodil Day (Friday 29 August) local volunteers were stationed outside

Fresh Choice to receive donations and distribute the daffodils. Pauanui organiser Yana Silva said the total raised in Pauanui was \$1,574.90.

In Tairua, the Cancer Society's Daffodil Day raised a total of \$2,401! Fundraising efforts were spread over two days, Daffodil Day Friday and Saturday morning, to maximise impact. Tairua's organiser, Ros Rundle said, "It wouldn't have been possible without the help from local businesses who had counter collection boxes for the month of August, our wonderful volunteers, Rod Miller who donated the fresh daffodils and to everyone who donated so generously to the Cancer Society."

Ros also explained that the local community benefits from the national Cancer Society fundraiser because its cancer research and support to cancer sufferers throughout their treatment benefits all Kiwis.

In addition to the Cancer Society funds, there was another \$502 raised for the local Tairua /Pauanui Care

> & Cancer Support Group from the cake and produce stall sales. Tairua /Pauanui Care & Cancer Support Group provides local practical support

for those suffering and their families. This includes assisting with equipment such as wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, walking sticks, toilet frames and shower chairs. All input is to help the household function as normally as possible.
