Local election results thus far

The local elections have run their course! Postal votes and drop-off votes had been slowly accumulating over the preceding weeks as voters responded to the calls to heed the deadlines. Not even the eleventh-hour drama of the Tairua Library flood on Friday could stop the last minute voters dropping off their returns.

In fact, as the voting deadline approached, the voting progress figures across the District showed increasing improvement. Over the last week, the reported overall District return figure rose from 28% to 42%, while the Tairua-Pauanui figure revealed us as the most vote-conscious with over 50% returns. These are important figures as they speak to the interest in, and commitment to, local democracy.

So, our local elections are over and you (the electors) have spoken (ticked!). Our next cohort of District representatives have been chosen, and a wind of change has been revealed.

At the time of going to print, the preliminary results attributable to Tairua-Pauanui are as follows:

- Mayor: Peter Revell
- Te Tara o Te Ika Maori Ward Councillor: Michael Barlow (unopposed)
- South Eastern Ward Councillors: John Freer and Alison Smith
- Tairua-Pauanui Community Board: Georgina Bond, Warwick Brookes, Michael Bush, and Barry Roberts
- Waikato Regional Council: Warren Maher
- The District voted to not have a Maori Ward going forward.

Candidates with fewer than 20 votes between them will be considered too close to determine who is successful until special votes are counted. The final results

Wandersearch could help your family

Do you have someone in your family who suffers with cognitive impairment, such as Alzheimer's, dementia, autism, brain injury or Down Syndrome? Do they get lost at times and need assistance to find their way home? Then Wandersearch may be a resource that your family can use.

What is Wandersearch? It is a service that helps to find people, adults and children, whose impairment may cause them to wander off. The service is provided by the Land Search and Rescue Organisation, which operates New Zealand wide, and is offered at no cost to the families.

People at risk wear a small device, either a pendant around their neck or worn like a wristwatch. The equipment is simple, tamper-proof and robust. If a person wearing the pendant goes missing, Land Search and Rescue volunteers have the equipment to track the device. Every six months a member of Search & Rescue will change the device so you do not need to be concerned about changing batteries. A Wandersearch device will operate anywhere within New

Zealand; so you can go visiting or on holiday within New Zealand, knowing that it will still work.


